DESCRIPTION

ARDEX Contact Vinyl Skirting Adhesive is designed for fixing vinyl skirting to plasterboard, timber or metal.

APPLICATION

Internal permanent installation of vinyl skirting.

IN THE ARDEX SYSTEM

SURFACE PREPARATION

All substrates must be structurally sound, level, protected from moisture, free from dust, oil, dirt and contaminants.

Contact ARDEX Technical Services for other substrates including terrazzo, ceramic tiles and metal substrates.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Refer to floor covering manufacturer's instructions. Condition adhesive and covering to working area temperature 24 hours prior to and 48 hours after installation.

Installation temperature of working area and substrate to be a minimum of 10°C and a maximum of 30°C. Apply an even coat of adhesive to both surfaces by brush or roller. On porous surfaces a second application may be required. Allow adhesive to touch dry. Align covering then press or roll to complete bond. Full strength will not be achieved for 24 hours.

NOTE: Do not reuse container. Dispose of container and adhesive residue in accordance with Federal, State and Local waste disposal regulations. Do not flush adhesive down drains.
