READING OF ARDEX FLOORING PRODUCT PRODUCTION CODES

Date, Wednesday, 17 September 2014

INTRODUCTION & SCOPE

Ardex Australia receives relatively regular inquiries about the manufacturing dates and shelf lives of products. The production information is clearly marked on the packaging either as an adhered label or ink printed on the bag. Shelf life information is including within the product instructions.

This technical bulletin is intended to assist customers in reading the product information on Ardex Flooring product packaging, and applies to products made locally by Ardex Australia (AAU) or imported from Ardex GmbH (AXD) and Ardex New Zealand (ANZ).

THE PACKAGING

Ardex flooring products are supplied in either paper bags, or plastic bottles and pails.

THE PRODUCT MANUFACTURING LABELS

Dry powder products have two kinds of label attached:

For 20kg bagged products manufactured by AAU, the batch details are printed in black ink on the side of the bags (e.g. K15, K12, Arditex NA etc).

Ardex Feather Finish (10kg) has a small self adhesive label 40x40mm applied to the bag end.

Ardex Feather Finish 4.5kg has a 40x40mm self adhesive label applied onto either the plastic pail, or the older paper bag.

For 25kg bagged products manufactured by AXD, the batch details are printed on to a self adhesive label 50x30mm with a bar code, which is applied onto the FRONT of the bag adjacent to the Ardex logo.

Liquid products

The liquids used for Ardex Flooring products; P51, P82, E25, Arditex NA Latex, WPM300/Ardex Moisture Barrier, WPM163 and the flooring adhesives have a 40x40mm self-adhesive label applied onto the container.

WHAT IS ON THE LABELS AND HOW IS THE INFORMATION INTERPRETED?

For Liquid Products and Non-NSW powders

The marking/labels for products manufactured by AAU contain a year, a month, a batch number and the state of manufacture. They also have the date of manufacture on packaging.

The first digit is the last part of the year, 8=2008, 10=2010, 12=2012 etc.,

The next letter is the month, A=Jan to L=December

The next two to three numbers is the batch number

The next letter is the state of manufacture, N=NSW, V=Vic, S=SA.

Some powder products may also have a bag number as part of the sequence.

For Ardex smoothing cement powders made in NSW after January 2 2007:

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The marking/labels for products manufactured by AAU contain a year, a month, a product code, the state of manufacture and the batch number. They also have the date of manufacture.

The first digit is the last part of the year, 9=2009, 10=2010, 12=2012 etc.,

The next letter is the month, A=Jan to L=December

The next two to three numbers is the product code

The next letter is the state of manufacture, N=NSW

The next three numbers are the product batch number

Ardex Imports from AXD (Powders and Liquids)

Products manufactured by AXD have a 15 digit number below the bar code. Read left to right the important numbers are: the first two digits are the month, the third is the year, followed by a four digit manufacturing code for the product.

similar is found on the back of 20kg AAU powder products and is **NOT** a manufacturing code.



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An example of an AXD 25kg bag powder product showing the position of the batching data label next to the Ardex logo on the bag front.

This applies to Ardex A46, K301, A55 and K1.

AXD production code from A46 bag above, read left to right 05=May 6=2006 5308=product code

This bar code or one similar is found on the bottom end of 25kg AXD powder products and is **NOT** a manufacturing code.

AAU production label as fixed to Feather Finish bags and pails. 6=2006 J=October 03=Batch number S=SA Production 05/10/06

AAU production label as fixed to Ardex B34/B36 mortar bags 7=2007 C=March 03=Batch number Q=QLD Production 12/03/07
